The Colorado Bowhunters Association Annual Awards Banquet will be held March 21, 2009, at the Crowne Plaza Hotel in Colorado Springs. This one-day event is filled with speakers, demonstrations, seminars, raffles, and, of course, the awards, auctions, and dinner. There will be between 400 and 600 people at the seminars and Banquet. Vendors will receive advertising in posters, programs and in the CBA magazine. We are asking for your help in making this event a success for you and the CBA.

This year we are featuring guest speakers, Tom Hoffman and Corky Richardson. Tom Hoffman was the first bowhunter to achieve the Ovis World Slam – twelve species of sheep. He also completed the Capra World Slam – twelve species of goats and has all 28 North American species in the Pope & Young Record Book. Corky Richardson is a very successful hunter holding numerous SCI and Pope & Young #1 records. Also highlighted are seminars and demonstrations by world champion elk caller, John Sarkisian; Primos Representative and premier elk and turkey caller, Chris Roe; and Llama outfitter, Gregg Romens. The day and evening will also include: Vendors and Exhibitors, Photo, Arrow building and Craft Contests, Colorado's Largest Big Game Trophy Display, Ladies Luncheon, Music by James Nichols, and a Social before dinner. Look for the Saturday schedule of events in the January-February issue of the CBA magazine.

The event will be open to the public. The cost per individual for the seminars, raffles, both auctions and Banquet is \$45 adult single, \$80 per couple, 17-13, \$30, 12 and under, \$10. For the seminars only, the cost is \$10 per adult, 17 and under are free.
